WHAT IS NET ZERO?

Governments across the globe have set mandates for municipalities to reach net-zero emissions by 2050. But according to the most recent report from the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), it's clear we need to hit that target sooner. In order to stop global warming, we all need to do our part – and we need a plan.



Finding funding can make or break your plan to take your rink to net zero carbon but there are several funding opportunities available to help you.



Federation of Canadian Municipalities

Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Reduction Pathway Feasibility Study Grant



- Ideal for municipalities who are just starting their path to Net Zero
- Feasibility study outlines the best approach to integrating energy and GHG reductions into longer-term plans
- Grant up to

\$65,000 for single buildings &
\$200,000 for a portfolio of buildings

and will cover up to

80% of eligible costs

- Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis, but you must submit a pre-application form

GHG Retrofit

- For buildings that have completed a feasibility study and is now looking to retrofit the building
- Financing for capital projects through a combination of loan and grant for retrofits

up to **\$5 million**

GHG Impact Retrofit

- Building must achieve a minimum of **30%** reduction in GHG emissions



GHG Reduction Pathway Retrofit

- Retrofits using an **outcomes-oriented approach** to achieving near **NET ZERO** carbon emissions over time

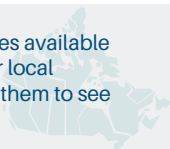


Infrastructure Canada's Green and Inclusive Community Buildings (GICB) Program

- Funding for **80%** of eligible project costs for retrofits up to **\$3 million**
- Projects are encouraged to achieve at least **25%** in energy efficiency improvements. Projects with greater energy efficiency improvements will receive a higher score
- All retrofit projects must be planned to be completed between April 1, 2021 and March 31, 2026
- Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis until the money runs out
- Applicants must submit their building information, energy profile, and GHG emissions using the RETScreen® Expert software



There are also other funding opportunities available through the provinces, utilities and other local organizations, so don't forget to contact them to see what they are offering in your area!
